David has also officiated numerous international club matches, including serving as the Junior AR on the FC Barcelona vs. CD Guadalajara, Mexico international club game at Candlestick Park this past August. David was the only non-FIFA official appointed by USSF to work any of the three games for the FC Barcelona tour in the U.S. this past summer.

Most recently, David has just been selected to officiate at the 2009 NCAA Division 1 Women's Soccer Championships in December at College Station, Texas.

David's presentation will consist of the latest video clips from recent MLS games, which MLS and USSF used for their mid-season professional national referee training. Foul recognition and game management strategies will be applied to similar youth game situations. David will also participate in an open-forum Q&A session.

His keen understanding of youth referee development and mentoring of professional referees for over two decades will benefit referees, coaches, players and spectators of all age levels.
